NARCAN (naloxone) Nasal Spray is available from your pharmacist without a prescription from your doctor. NARCAN is also covered by most major insurance plans. Anyone can purchase NARCAN Nasal Spray directly from a pharmacist without a doctor's prescription. All major pharmacy chains (such as CVS, Walgreen's, and RiteAid) stock NARCAN Nasal Spray, so it's convenient for you to obtain today. You can download the prescription request aid and present to your pharmacist to obtain NARCAN Nasal Spray today.

THROUGH INSURANCE

NARCAN Nasal Spray has extensive public and private insurance coverage. In fact, 97% of U.S. insured lives have access to NARCAN Nasal Spray.*
