

Fairview Lake Covid Safety Guidelines

These are the requirements and safeguards in place to ensure a healthy weekend

- Everyone must have a mask with them at all times. They will need to wear their mask anytime they go inside, and anytime they are outside and cannot maintain a 6' social distance from people (staff/other guests) that are not in their cohort.
- Upon arrival everyone will need to have their temperature taken, and answer the following screening questions:
 - 1. Have you been in close contact with a confirmed case of COVID-19?
 - 2. Are you experiencing a cough, shortness of breath or sore throat?
 - 3. Have you had a fever in the last 48 hours?
 - 4. Have you had a new loss of taste or smell?
 - 5. Have you had vomiting or diarrhea in the last 24 hours?
 - 6. Have you visited any of the following states in the last 14 days? Alabama, Alaska, Arizona, Arkansas, Colorado, Florida, Georgia, Guam, Idaho, Illinois, Indiana, Iowa, Kansas, Kentucky, Louisiana, Maryland, Michigan, Minnesota, Mississippi, Missouri, Montana, Nebraska, Nevada, New Mexico, North Carolina, North Dakota, Ohio, Oklahoma, Puerto Rico, Rhode Island, South Carolina, South Dakota, Tennessee, Texas, Utah, Virginia, West Virginia, Wisconsin & Wyoming (this list gets updated as needed)
- **Persons with temperature over 100.4F or answering yes to any questions shall not be admitted to the property.**
- Everyone will have their temperature taken and be asked the screening questions above every day at breakfast.
- Before arrival or upon arrival everyone will need to sign a COVID-19 waiver (or their parents will need to sign on their behalf if they are under 18)
- All equipment and spaces are being sanitized on a regular basis, in addition to regular cleaning.
